NOTIFICATION

NO. S.O. (PH) 17-1 / 69 (V-III). Pursuant to the approval of the Competent Authority, the Government of the Punjab, Health Department has decided that all the Provincial Government employees (both serving or retired) from BS-01-22, and their dependent family members, suffering from following chronic diseases, will be entitled for re-imbursement of amount spent on account of purchases of medicines for the medical treatment at OPDs of all the Public Sector Hospitals functioning under the administrative control of Punjab Health Department in addition to Cancer, Hepatitis B & C, and Insulin Dependent Diabetes Mellitus (IDDM):

- i. Chronic Pulmonary-Cardiovascular & Circulatory Disorders
- ii. Tumors, Malignancies, Cancer and chronic blood disorders (Thalassacmia etc.)
- iii. Chronic Hepato-Renal, Disorders, Organ Failure, Dialysis and Transplants
- iv. Chronic Neuro-Psychiatric Diseases, Neuropathies, Epilepsy, Paralysis
- v. Chronic, Inflammatory-Infectious Diseases (Rheumatoid Arthritis, Hepatitis, TB, Telaecus etc.)
- vi. Chronic Endocrine Disorder (Diabetes, Goiter, Pancreatitis etc)
- vii. Chronic Degenerative Disorders
- viii. Poisoning, Dog and Snake Bite
- ix. Drug Abuse, STD, HIV/AIDS, VHF
- x. Chronic Skin Diseases, Allergies - Chronic Connective Tissue and Autoimmune Disorders
- xi. Injuries including Orthopaedics, Burns, Gun-shot, Blast and Head Injuries
- xii. Day Surgery (Obstetric-Gynae Disorders, Deliveries, Cataract and Eye / ENT day procedures)
- xiii. Shock, Cardiogenic Shock, Stroke and Electrolyte Disorders
- xiv. Treatment for Eye, ENT and Disabilities / Handicaps
- xv. Dental ailments

2. The financial impact arises out from re-imbursement of medical charges in the matter will be met out of the budget allocated to each Department / Institution.

3. The procedures / instructions circulated vide this Department's letters of even number, dated 23-08-2005, 26-01-2006, 31-08-2006, 25-01-2007 and 04-01-2012, shall be applicable as usual.
